**All Resident Advisors will be selling Old Kentucky chocolate bars for \$1 each Please consider buying some if you are able!**

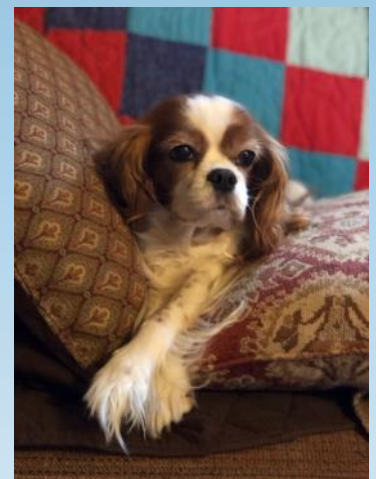
Opening Convocation will be on January 15th at 1 PM in CAC. It will be required of all full time students to attend.

# Weekly Devotional

**“Therefore**, since we are surrounded by so great a **cloud of witnesses**, let us also **lay aside every weight, and sin** which clings so closely, and let us **run with endurance** the race that is set before us, **looking to Jesus**, the author and perfecter of our faith...” Hebrews 12:1-2

- The word **“therefore”** seen in these verses is a transitional word used as a result of something important coming before it. From Hebrews chapter 10:9 to chapter 12 we see a **“cloud of witnesses”** that set a great example of living by faith. As a result, Christians should be inspired by those godly examples before them.
- **Lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely-** We must repent from our sins and allow God to cleanse us in order to receive salvation. In order to do so, we have faith that He will make us exactly who He needs us to be. When a runner runs a race, he doesn't wear a big jacket, boots, and heavy pants. He gets rid of everything that is going to get in the way or slow him down. We have to treat our sin the same way. If it isn't helping you, get rid of it.
- **Run with endurance-** Endurance is the determination to keep going, no matter how hard it may get.
- **Looking to Jesus-** we find our source of strength, our salvation, our motivation to keep “running the race” and every other aspect of the Christian life through Jesus. We look to Jesus as the object of faith and salvation.
