 local community that include the dispositions of
 character, capability, and service.
- A satisfactory recommendation from the Director of the Student Work Program
- A satisfactory State Criminal Background Check and Negative Drug Test
- A satisfactory interview by Teacher Education Committee

Stage 2- Admission to Student Teaching

- Complete formal application to Student Teaching
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better
- Satisfactory completion of required clinical and field experiences
- (Student teaching will require documentation of at least 200 hours)
- Maintain current required student work performance
