Meeting 2: 10/06/23

The SGA meeting took place on October $\mathbf{6}^{\text {th }}, \mathbf{2 0 2 3}$. The second meeting of the semester was called to order by President Zachary Willis in "Pippa's Room" in DSC at approximately 6:35 PM. The present members were President: Zachary Willis, Executive Vice President: Kolby Combs, Vice President of Administration: McKenna Wireman, Vice President of Campus Involvement: Peyton Boblett, Junior Representatives: Neeley Greene and Carlos Villanueva, Sophomore Representatives: Rachel Rife and McKenzie Slone, and Freshman Representative: Micah Turner. The absent members were Vice President of Student Life: Abi Dobson (excused), Senior Representative: Shelby Short, and Freshman Representative: Maddux Camden (excused).

President Willis started off the meeting by introducing the new members, and petitioning for a nomination for the fulfillment of the roles of Vice President of Administration and Vice President of Campus Involvement. McKenna Wireman and Peyton Boblett were nominated for these roles, respectively, and voted in. Collectively, the group decided to use Facebook Messenger as our form of communication with each other rather than GroupMe. A paper was then passed around to gather contact information, as well as shirt sizes. The formation of committees was also discussed. President Willis opened the floor for members to volunteer for each committee. Sophomore \& Junior Representatives MacKenzie Slone and Carlos Villanueva volunteered for the dance committee under VP's Combs Wireman. Meeting was adjourned at 7:01 PM and lasted approximately 26 minutes.
