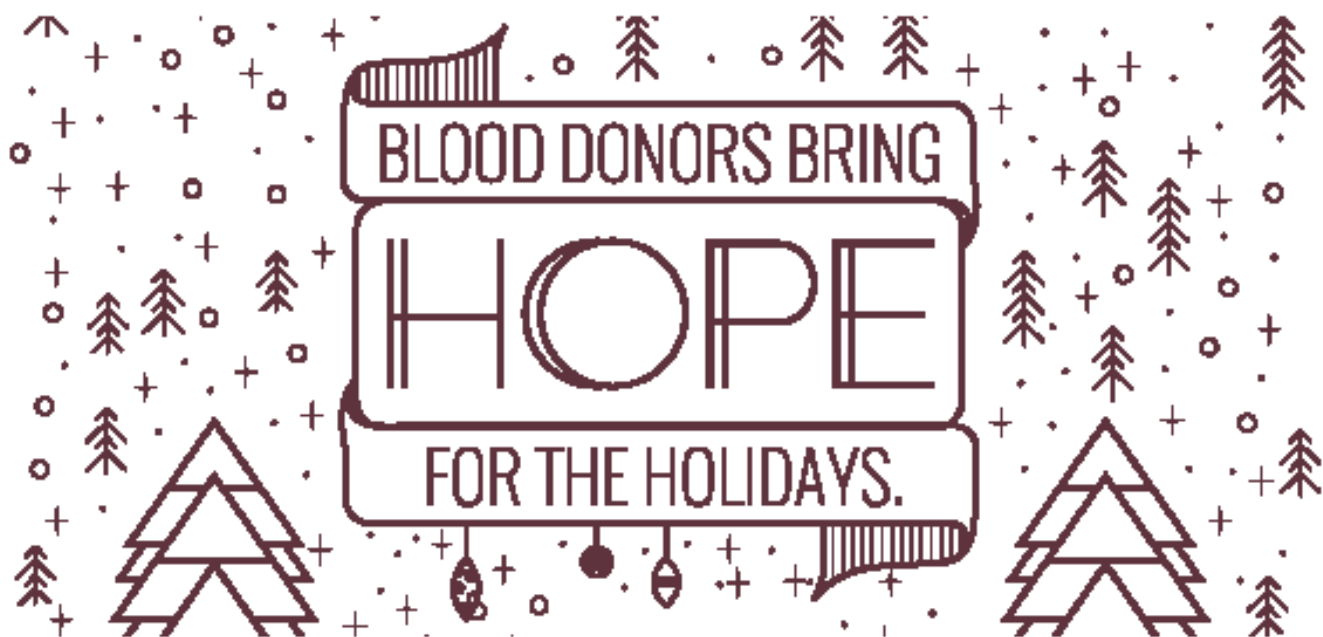

Meeting 2: 10/06/23

The SGA meeting took place on **October 6th, 2023**. The second meeting of the semester was called to order by President Zachary Willis in “Pippa’s Room” in DSC at approximately **6:35 PM**. The present members were President: Zachary Willis, Executive Vice President: Kolby Combs, Vice President of Administration: McKenna Wireman, Vice President of Campus Involvement: Peyton Boblett, Junior Representatives: Neeley Greene and Carlos Villanueva, Sophomore Representatives: Rachel Rife and McKenzie Slone, and Freshman Representative: Micah Turner. The absent members were Vice President of Student Life: Abi Dobson (excused), Senior Representative: Shelby Short, and Freshman Representative: Maddux Camden (excused).

President Willis started off the meeting by introducing the new members, and petitioning for a nomination for the fulfillment of the roles of Vice President of Administration and Vice President of Campus Involvement. McKenna Wireman and Peyton Boblett were nominated for these roles, respectively, and voted in. Collectively, the group decided to use Facebook Messenger as our form of communication with each other rather than GroupMe. A paper was then passed around to gather contact information, as well as shirt sizes. The formation of committees was also discussed. President Willis opened the floor for members to volunteer for each committee. Sophomore & Junior Representatives MacKenzie Slone and Carlos Villanueva volunteered for the dance committee under VP’s Combs Wireman. This left Junior Representative Greene, Sophomore Representative Rife, and Freshman Representative Turner to be part of the CISL (Campus Involvement and Student Life) committee under VP’s Dobson and Boblet.

Sophomore Representative Rachel Rife presented the idea of creating a Google Form to link to a QR code for students to scan and be able to submit their concerns to SGA. Vice President Combs brought back the idea put forth by Sophomore Representative Rachel Rife at the first meeting about setting apart one meeting a month to be open to students to attend, and possibly for a convocation credit. President Willis concluded the meeting by stressing the importance of showing up to the meetings and being active members of SGA.

Meeting was adjourned at **7:01 PM** and lasted **approximately 26 minutes**.

Three Light Bulbs and Three Switches

SOLUTION TO THE RIDDLE:

In order to determine which switches go with which light bulbs, this is what you must do:

- *Turn the first switch on.
- *Turn the second light switch on.
- *Leave the third light switch off.
- *Wait 15 minutes and turn the second light switch off. Now enter the room with the light bulbs.
