Meeting 3: 10/19/23 President: Zachary Willis

Executive Vice President: Kolby Combs

The SGA meeting took place on **October 19th**, **2023**. The third meeting of the semester was called to order by President Zachary Willis in Room 205 in JBAC at approximately **6:30 PM**. The present members were President: Zachary Willis, Executive Vice President: Kolby Combs, Vice President of Administration: McKenna Wireman, Vice President of Campus Involvement: Peyton Boblett, Vice President of Student Life: Abi Dobson, Junior Representatives: Neeley Greene and Carlos Villanueva, Freshman Representatives: Micah Turner and Dylan Pierce. The absent members were Sophomore Representatives: Rachel Rife (excused) and McKenzie Slone (excused), and Senior Representative: Chase Petry (excused).

President Willis started off the meeting by petitioning for a nomination for the fulfillment of the roles Freshman Representative and Senior Representative. Dylan Pierce and Chase Petry were nominated for these roles, respectively, and voted in. President Willis discussed the Trunk or Treat event and the SGA Table, emphasizing that he would like for all the group members to be present to have the group heard and let the students know that the group would be there for them. Executive Vice President Combs then discussed the community service projects to gather everyone's thoughts. He spoke with Holly Thacker, the activities director, at the Knott County Nursing Home, and she explained how the residents love receiving cards from others. Collectively, the group decided that the members would send them Christmas cards, along with peppermint candies and/or candy canes, with each card specialized for a resident. The members also learned that the residents love to play bingo, so the group decided what day and time would be best for most of the members to make a trip over and play bingo with the residents. Collectively, the group decided on a Thursday at 2:00 PM. President Willis also discussed getting more boxes to place around campus for the pet food drive, as well as making posters. President Willis stated that after Thanksgiving, he would like for the group to do a clothing/ food drive since the weather will be getting colder.

President Willis also discussed the JBS CIA Dance. Executive Vice President Combs said that the dance committee will be meeting to discuss decorations, concessions, etc. Vice President Combs also stated that the committees need to begin meeting more frequently to discuss various topics, and that we could make a group chat for each committee to discuss the best time for said meetings.

President Willis then opened the floor for any concerns that members had heard about. Freshman Representative Micah Turner said that he had heard students suggest that the Hunger Din hours be extended, and many people were concerned with the Wi-Fi signal around campus. President Willis said that the stairs inside the boy's dorm needed to be fixed. Junior Representative Carlos Villanueva said that the vending machines needed to be fixed or replaced. Vice President of Campus Involvement Peyton Boblett suggested some different activities for students to be able to attend, such as an ice cream social, a bingo night, and some board games in hang out areas on campus.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:56 PM and lasted approximately 26 minutes.


Message to All Students from Dean Mills

Circular Divisions

Solution:

Many people will first split the circle into nine sections, then quickly they'll make it ten sections, and eventually some people will make it to eleven sections, which is the maximum number. There are obviously ways to split the circle into eleven sections, but here is one

solution:

Take the circle and imagine it as a clock face.

Draw a line form the twelve to the six, the two to the seven, the three to the nine, and then the final line goes from the five to a place between the eleven and twelve. This results in eleven sections.
